

## For Sale: Two looms

Up for fast sale, my lovely Glimaka loom (sadly I have no room). It is a standard horizontal counterbalance loom. It has 100 cm (39 inches) weaving width, 8-10 shafts, 10 treadles. It is made of good hard wood (Swedish pine) and comes with several hundreds of texsolv heddles (I bought extra), a 35/100 cm (8.75 dpi) reed, 2 lease sticks, several warping sticks, 4 non-skid foot covers, tie-up cords, 2 shaft holders, 4 large wire shaft pins, elastic hangers ("shaft bra"), lots of lock pegs (both arrow and 2-leg anchor), and upper support cross bar (good for use in counterbalance mode - though no accessories for that with it). There is a bench included....original adjustable-height. The footprint is width at 53 inches and depth at 65 inches. Dismantling and delivery to be negotiated. Asking \$1750 CDN obo.
